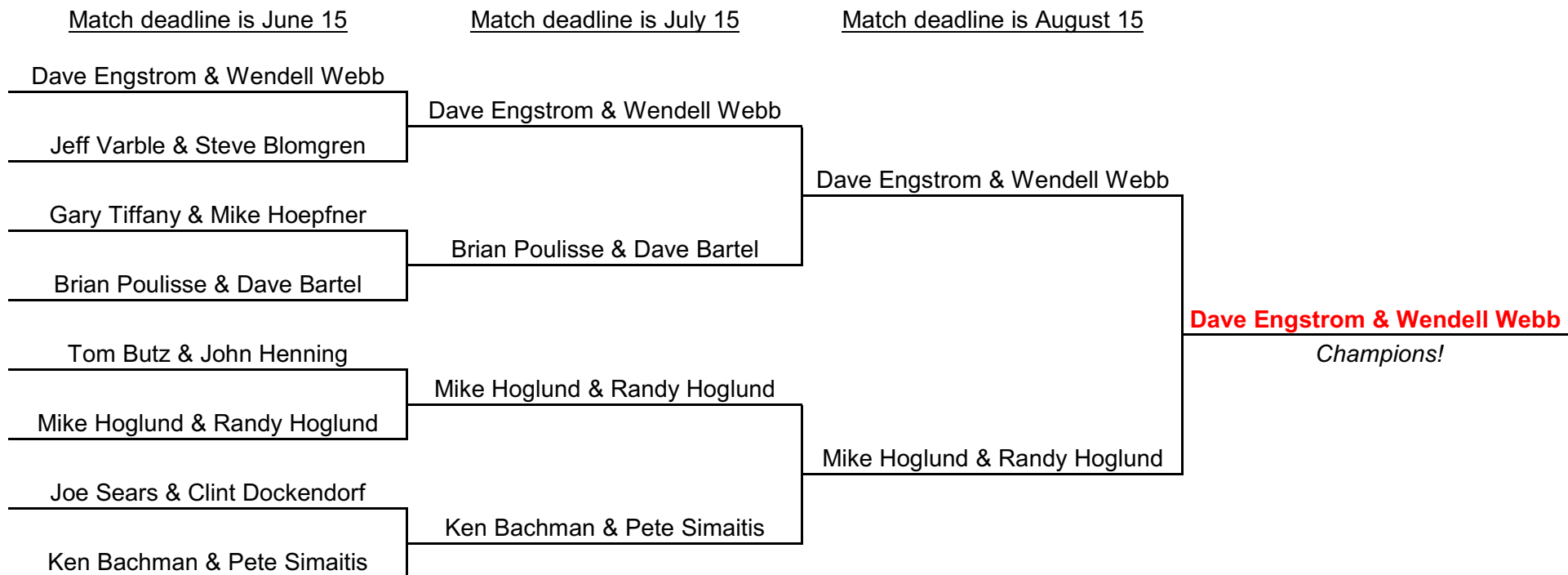


2011 Partners Match Play Tournament

(as of September 3, 2011)



This is a fully-handicapped tournament. Players should call their opponent as soon as possible to schedule their match. Matches can be played on any area course that is agreeable to both players, and at any tees. If an agreement cannot be reached, a coin should be flipped with the winner choosing the course and the loser choosing the tees. The only exception is if you played the same opponent last year, the loser of that match gets to select the course.

To figure handicaps for the match, compare your handicap index (i.e., 15.1) to the posted course handicap sheet for the tees you will play. **Partners should add their actual handicaps for the course and tees together as their team handicap. Subtract the lower team handicap from the higher team handicap and assign the difference to the team with the higher handicap and to the most difficult holes as assigned by the course of play.** Each player plays his own ball and the partners' scores are added together to get the team score for the hole. The lowest team score wins the hole (i.e., Team A shoots a 4 & a 6, Team B shoots a 4 & a 5. Team B wins the hole unless Team A gets a stroke on the hole, which would halve the hole).

All matches should be 18-hole matches. Please decide before the match starts how you will settle the match if it ends in a tie. Options include: Sudden Death; a 3-, 6-, or 9-hole playoff; another 18-hole match; a back-count playoff starting at hole 18 or hole 9; or any other method acceptable to all participants. Those matches not played by the dates specified above will be decided by a flip of a coin by the Tournament Committee. Match results are to be reported to Tournament Chairman John Henning at 815-633-3133 or johnk_henning_523@comcast.net within 48 hours of the match so they can be posted to the web site.

Disputes not resolved by mutual agreement of the contestants are to be reported to John Henning prior to any further matches. John will then obtain an official ruling from the club officers, whose decision will be final.
